EGG FACTS

With only 70 calories each, eggs are rich in nutrients. In varying amounts, they contain almost every essential vitamin and mineral needed by humans, as well as, several other beneficial food components.

A large egg contains over 6 grams of protein and 4.5 grams of fat, which is only 7% of the daily value. Only one-third (1.5) grams is saturated fat, and 2 grams are mono-unsaturated fat.
